

# Grace and Peace Quilt Ministries, Inc.

## BABY WRAP

*“They are children of God raised up to new life.” Luke 20:36*

Finished wrap approximately 27” x 27”

### FABRICS

Fabric Light – (print) 19”

Fabric Dark – (solid) 14” – Includes Border

Backing 30” square

There is no binding or batting with this quilt.

\* Note: If you desire to have the border in the light fabric, add 8” to light fabric requirements

### INSTRUCTIONS

**All fabric is cut by width of folded fabric.**

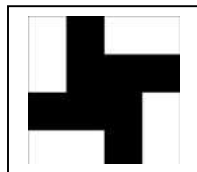
#### **Block A –**

*Light Fabric* - Cut (3) 2” wide strips.

*Dark Fabric* - Cut (7) 2” wide strips.

Sew a light and a dark strip together 3 times. Press seams to dark side.

Cut strips into (32) 3 ½” long pieces. Take four of those pieces and assemble them into a block as shown below. Press seams (doesn’t matter which direction). Make (8) 6 ½” square blocks.



#### **Block B -**

Cut (2) 6 ½” wide strips of light (print) fabric. Cut same strips again into (8) 6 ½” squares.

Lay out your quilt according to the pattern below. Assembly line sew rows together carefully matching seams. Press seams.

### Borders

Measure quilt in the center from side to side. Cut 2 of the remaining 2” dark strips to this size. Sew to the quilt top and bottom. Press seams toward border.

Measure quilt in the center from side to side (including borders). Cut remaining 2 of the dark strips to this size, and add to quilt sides. Press seams toward borders.

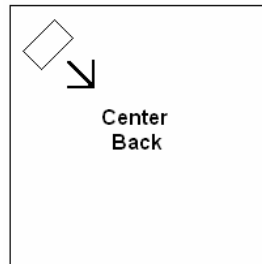

## **Finishing**

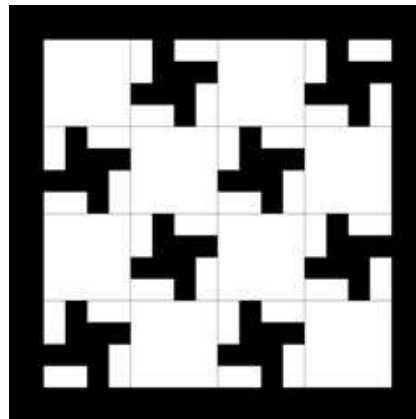
Measure size of completed quilt top. Cut backing fabric slightly larger than top. Place right sides together and sew around perimeter of quilt, leaving an opening for turning. Trim seams and corners, turn quilt and press.

You may finish this quilt either by quilting or tying. Quilting can consist of stitching in the ditch around each block or however you prefer. If you tie this quilt it is recommended you use embroidery floss (all 6 strands) and tie at each corner.

The label for this quilt is placed on the back in the top corner as show below. There is no pocket.
